Lewis University moves into the No. 1 position in the NSCAA/adidas Division II Men's poll, overtaking previous No. 1 and defending NCAA champion Cal State Dominguez Hills. Lynn University, ranked fifth with a 9-0-0 mark, is the only remaining unbeaten, untied team among the top five. University of District of Columbia, also unblemished at 9-0-0, debuts in the rankings at No. 9 after a 5-2 win at No. 18 Wheeling Jesuit and a 3-1 victory at Charleston.

Five teams remain unbeaten in the latest NSCAA/adidas Division II Men's poll. Top-ranked Lynn, the only undefeated, untied team in the top 25 at 14-0-0, is No. 1 for the third-straight week. Lewis, ranked second, defeated Wisconsin-Parkside 1-0, moving to 15-0-1, No. 4 Dowling (9-0-3) defeated Mercy 7-1 and tied Southampton 1-1 and No. 6 Tampa dropped Saint Leo 3-0 to improve to 13-0-2. Outside of the top 10, Findlay, ranked 11th, picked up three wins and is 13-0-2 on the year.
