Northern Kentucky takes over the top spot in the NSCAA/adidas Women's Division II poll with a 7-0 mark after former No. 1 UC San Diego fell to San Francisco State 1-0. Franklin Pierce outscored its two weekend opponents 15-1 and moves up to No. 2 while previously mentioned San Francisco State climbs all the way to a tie for third after entering the Top 25 at No. 18 last week. West Florida joins SFSU at No. 3 and Regis completes the top five. UC San Diego (5-1) drops to No. 6 after its first loss of 2001.




2001 NCAA Division II Women - National October 8, 2001

The rest of last week's top five stays put with Franklin Pierce (No. 2), Regis (No. 3) and Christian Brothers (No. 4) also unbeaten. Bloomsburg rises from 12th to No. 6 after three wins, including a 3-2 overtime result versus Indiana (Pa.). Longwood also makes a big jump, tying for the ninth spot following No. 15 showings the previous two weeks.

Northern Kentucky defeated SIU-Edwardsville and Quincy by a combined 11-1 score and it maintains the No. 1 ranking in the NSCAA/adidas Division II Women's poll. Franklin Pierce picked up three wins and holds at No. 2 while Christian Brothers joins Regis in a tie for third. Bloomsburg drops from sixth to 21st after falling to Lock Haven 2-0 and Slippery Rock 3-1. Longwood also slips from the top 10 to No. 20 following a 2-1 loss at the hands of Belmont Abbey, now ranked ninth.


