Williams stays at No. 2 while Kean moves up to third, trading places with now No. 4 Claremont. Saint Lawrence moves into the top five at No. 5 after sitting sixth in the last poll. Otterbein slips from fifth to 25th after falling to previously unranked John Carroll 3-2 in overtime. Plattsburgh State (No. 15), John Carroll (No. 20) and Washington & Lee (no. 24) are new to the top 25 this week.

The top three teams remain the same in the latest NSCAA/adidas Division III Men's poll, but the rest of the top 10 sees many changes. Messiah, Williams and Kean are first, second and third for the second week in a row while No. 4 Saint Lawrence headlines the shake-up in the rest of the poll. No. 14 Trinity and No. 17 Wilmington fell from the top 10 with Kalamazoo (seventh) and Wisconsin-Oshkosh (eighth) filling the vacated slots. Rochester is the highest newcomer to the rankings, appearing 13th after receiving votes a week ago.

The aforementioned loss drops Messiah to No. 2 while Saint Lawrence, Claremont and Kean wrap up the top five. Richard Stockton defeated No. 5 Kean 3-2 and climbs to within one place of the top 10 and No. 15 Roanoke (12-2-0) and No. 19 Arcadia (15-0-1) make the highest debuts in this week's rankings.

Saint Lawrence, Williams, Richard Stockton and Greensboro round out the top five, respectively, in the final regular season rankings. Norwich, fourth in the New England region and receiving votes in the national poll, is 20-0-0 in 2001 and hopes a solid performance in NCAA play will help it gain widespread respect.
