The top five remains intact in the NSCAA/adidas Division III Women's poll with College of New Jersey leading the way at No. 1. TCNJ shut out Rutgers-Newark (7-0) and Ramapo (3-0) to remain unblemished at 7-0-0. No. 2 Trinity blitzed University of the South 7-0 and Centre 6-0 and upped its mark to 6-0. No. 3 Wisconsin-Steven's Point and No. 4 Willamette each improved to 5-0 with No. 5 Ohio Wesleyan checking in at 7-1 after three victories this week.

OWU defeated Amherst 1-0 with senior forward Katy Sturtz providing the game-winner for the Bishops. Amherst completes 2001 as the No. 2 team in the rankings with NCAA semifinalsts Willamette and Wheaton (III.) third and fourth, respectively.
